### NVSA Range Safety Rules

1. Treat all firearms as though they are loaded at all times.
2. Never point a firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.
3. All firearms are to remain unloaded and holstered or cased unless the shooter is on the firing line with a member of the range staff, or in the safe handling area with an unloaded weapon. No firearms handling will be allowed in the parking lot, etc., No dry firing or other firearm manipulation will be allowed outside of the SAFE HANDLING AREA. (No live ammo in the Safe Handling Area)
4. All loading and unloading of firearms will take place on the firing line under the direct supervision of range staff.
5. Clearing malfunctions is the responsibility of the shooter. Shooters are expected to continue the course of fire while resolving the malfunction. Range staff will intercede only if necessary.
6. Shooters on the firing line shall not break 180 degrees with the muzzle of their firearm. (Under no circumstances will the muzzle point up-range). Shooters shall not point their weapons over the top of any of the protective berms.
7. Consumption of alcohol or intoxicants immediately before or during range use is strictly forbidden. Any shooter taking any performance affecting medication must report this to range staff before any weapons firing.
8. Eye and Ear protection are mandatory for all persons on the range when a competition is underway.
9. All Steel targets are to be used on the East side Bay. No Steel of ANY KIND may be used on the Western Bay.
10. Members purposely damaging any piece of NVSA range equipment will be expelled from the club.
11. NVSA members must be members of IDPA. (The exception is original Life Members)
12. No Long Guns of any kind may be shot at the NVSA range

# RELEASE FROM RESPONSIBILITY, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK FOR PARTICIPATION IN A DANGEROUS ACTIVITY

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of permitting THE UNDERSIGNED to enter the NORTH VALLEY SHOOTING CLUB premises, for the purposes of firearms use, shooting firearms, observing the shooting of firearms, or any and all other purposes, THE UNDERSIGNED, for herself, himself, her/his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

1. Hereby voluntarily releases, discharges, waives and relinquishes any and all actions for the personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to the UNDERSIGNED arising as a result of engaging in or being present at the activities at the NORTH VALLEY SHOOTING ASSOCIATION premises.
2. Hereby covenants not to sue and voluntarily releases, waives, discharges and relinquishes any action or causes of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for herself/himself and for her/his estate, and agrees that under no circumstances will she/he or her/his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns prosecute or present any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against NORTH VALLEY SHOOTER ASSOCIATION, or any of it's officers, agents, servants or employees for any said causes of action, whether the same shall rise by negligence of any said persons or otherwise. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE UNDERSIGNED BY THIS INSTRUMENT, TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE NORTH VALLEY SHOOTERS ASSOCIATIONS, OR ANY OF IT'S OFFICERS, AGENTS, SERVANTS, OR EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS, FROM ANY LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE.
3. Agrees that in the event of any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against NORTH VALLEY SHOOTER ASSOCIATION, the Undersigned shall indemnify and save harmless the same NORTH VALLEY SHOOTER ASSOCIATION and any of it's officers, agents, servants, employees or volunteers from any and all claims or cause of action by whomever or whatever or wherever made or presented for personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death.
4. Agrees that the forgoing release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws applicable in the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledges that the UNDERSIGNED has been fully and completely advised of the potential for serious accident incidental to engaging in firearm activities, and expressly agrees to assume all risks of loss, injury and property damage, and expressly agrees to assume all risks of loss, damage or injury that may be sustained by the UNDERSIGNED.
6. **THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ THE FOREGOING PARAGRAPHS AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THIS AGREEMENT BEING FULLY AWARE OF THE LEGAL CONSEQUENCES OF SIGNED THE WITHIN INSTRUMENT.**
